RESEARCH COMPETITION **CATEGORIES**

- - Advancements in LNG production, transportation, storage, and utilization.
 - Topics may include decarbonization technologies, operational safety & risk management, digitalization in LNG, process optimization, and integration with renewables.
- **Environmental Sustainability**
 - Solutions for reducing environmental impact across the LNG value chain.
 - Topics may include emissions reduction, carbon capture and storage (CCS), biodiversity protection, water management, and circular economy initiatives.
- Business, Policy, and Societal Impact
 - The intersection of LNG with economics, policy, and social outcomes. Topics may include market dynamics, regulatory
 - frameworks, energy equity, stakeholder engagement, indigenous partnerships, and community impacts.
- **Workforce Development and Diversity**
 - Focuses on strategies to build, diversify, and future-proof for LNG workforce.
 - Topics may include skills training, education pathways, equity-centered leadership development in the energy sector.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

All participants are required to submit an abstract for initial review and acceptance. Please adhere to the following guidelines when preparing your abstract:

- **Content Requirements** Title: Should be concise, clear, and reflect the
 - essence of your work. Authors and Affiliations: Include full names and
 - institutional affiliations of all authors. Please note that only the first contestant listed will be the actual contestant. Background/Introduction: Brief context for your
 - research/project. Objectives: Clearly state the purpose of the work
 - or research question. Methods: Summarize the methods or approach
 - used (if applicable). Results: Highlight key findings or anticipated
 - outcomes. Conclusion/Impact: Summarize major

conclusions and relevance or potential impact.





- **Formatting Instructions for Abstract**
 - Word Limit: Maximum 500 words. Language: English
- **Submission Guidelines**
 - Applicants must submit an abstract by September 12, 2025 and will be notified by September 19, 2025 if they are selected to present in-person at the competition.
 - Applicants who are selected to present in the in-person competition must be present during a portion of the competition period; additional information will be provided after September 19, 2025. All applicants will be notified of their status following this date, regardless of whether they are chosen to advance or not.
 - **Submission method:** Abstracts are to be submitted by September 12, 2025 via this link.
- **Evaluation Criteria**

Abstracts will be evaluated based on:

- Clarity and relevance
- Scientific or conceptual merit Innovation and originality
- **General Notes**
 - All accepted abstracts will require a corresponding poster presentation to be presented at the Americas LNG Summit & Exhibition.
 - Posters must match the content described in the abstract.
 - Shortlisted submitters must be available to present their posters on October 20, 2025 at the Americas LNG Summit & Exhibition.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTERS

- Successful candidates are to produce and bring their 1. poster to the Americas LNG Summit & Exhibition. Use a PowerPoint slide with the measurements of
- 3'x4' (landscape) to create your poster. A template is available for downloading below. Only use high quality images. Make sure that images
- are at least 200 dpi resolutions. Leave a small amount of space on all four edges of the
- poster in order to ensure that no images are cut off.
